



Travel Document Checklist

Travel Document/Certificate of Travel Required Documentation	
Biometric Residence Permit (BRP), OR a picture of both sides of BRP to provide: Status, nationality, country of birth, place of birth, date of birth. <u>All details and spelling must be correct on your BRP, if not, you should report the error and wait for a new BRP before applying.</u>	
National Insurance Number	
Valid and accessible Email address - you will need to create a UKVI account and verify email links during the application process	
Valid phone number	
Home Address, and details of how long you have lived there	
Home Office Reference Number (any) – these can be found on your Home Office letters	
2 Passport Photos – digital photos are not acceptable	
<p><u>At least one</u> of these documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leave to remain status letter • Current or expired home office travel document • Current or expired national passport or other travel document issued inside or outside the UK European uniform format forms on which visa are affixed (formerly GV3) • Foreign identity cards • Visa promise letters <p>This evidence will be sent to Home Office with your application and returned to you by post</p>	
Your Sponsor details (if applicable) If you came to the UK through Family Reunion, or to join a family member on another type of visa: Name, Home Office Reference Number, Date of the Birth, Nationality	
Date claiming asylum, if applicable, and date of enrolling biometrics	
Details of previous or pending immigration applications e.g. date of asylum application, student visa, indefinite leave to remain	
Required fee and card payment method	
Birth Certificate for children’s applications – (professionally translated if applicable)	
<p>Certificate of Travel only – Provide evidence that you have been ‘unreasonably refused’ a passport from your country’s national authorities, or that you have an important reason to travel.</p> <p>Check Home Office Guidance if either of these situations apply to you: www.gov.uk/apply-home-office-travel-document/certificate-of-travel </p>
